For a small number of students, Biddulph High School works with local Colleges to offer vocational courses. Currently we have students studying at both Stoke On Trent College and Reaseheath College.

Both colleges offer a variety of vocational courses to suit the practical needs of some of our learners. The bespoke programmes are successful in providing individuals with a 'hands on' experience in a specific area of interest.

Work Experience

In addition, we work with a number of local businesses to provide students with work experience opportunities throughout the academic year helping individuals to develop work based practical skills.

The Hub

At Biddulph High School we promote inclusive provision through the use of the Hub. The Hub provides small group teaching for students who struggle to access the mainstream education for various reasons. This allows them to continue to study Level 2 qualifications in GCSE English, Maths, Science and History, BTEC IT as well as the Prince's Trust pathway.

Biddulph High School's Hub also works with different alternative provision providers to enable students to access a variety of ASDAN short courses to suit the needs and interests of the individuals, for example; gardening and animal care.
