Y13 – Unit 4

This unit deepens knowledge of the approaches content from Unit 1 in order to explain whether criminals born or made?

The unit examines a number of different explanations for criminal behaviour and analyses the different ways to treat criminal behaviour

Y13 – Unit 3

Health psychology explores how psychological and physiological factors affect health and ill health.

This unit includes approaches, theories and studies that investigate reasons for behaviour, such as addiction and stress. This unit also explores the effectiveness of different treatments in psychology.

Y12 – Unit 2

Psychological research is at the heart of the BTEC course and this unit identifies, analyses and applies the importance of this process.

Students will investigate the scientific process behind research, as well as the ethical considerations involved in psychological research, and understanding the entire process from concept to completion.

The approaches unit investigates how four of the main viewpoints in psychology help us to understand behaviour.

The Cognitive, Social, Learning and Biological are used to explain aggression in society, how psychology is used to explain and influence consumer behaviour, and how it can explain gender
