## Entry Requirements 2024-25

| A LEVEL COURSE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS |  |
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| Art and Textiles | You must have obtained a grade 4 in GCSE English Language or English Literature, plus four further <br> higher grade passes (this includes grade 4 or above in GCSE subjects or Level 2 Pass or above in BTEC <br> subjects) including grade 4 in GCSE Art or GCSE Graphics or GCSE Product Design or GCSE Textiles. |
| Biology | A minimum of three grade $6 s$ and five grade 5 s at GCSE including a grade 6 in Maths GCSE and grade 7 <br> Biology GCSE or Combined Science. |
| Business Studies | A minimum of three grade $6 s$ and five grade 5 s at GCSE including a grade 5 in GCSE English Language <br> and Maths (you do not need to have studied GCSE Business). |
| Chemistry | A minimum of three grade $6 s$ and five grade 5 s at GCSE including a grade 6 in Maths GCSE and grade 7 <br> in Chemistry GCSE or Combined Science. |
| Computer Science | A minimum of three grade $6 s$ and five grade $5 s$ at GCSE including a grade 5 in GCSE English Language <br> and grade 6 in GCSE Maths. |
| English Language | A minimum of three grade $6 s$ and five grade $5 s$ at GCSE including a grade 6 in GCSE English Language <br> and English Literature. |
| English Literature | A minimum of three grade $6 s$ and five grade $5 s$ at GCSE including a grade 6 in GCSE English Language <br> and English Literature. |
| Geography | A minimum of three grade $6 s$ and five grade $5 s$ at GCSE including a grade 6 in GCSE English Language or <br> English Literature. If GCSE Geography was studied, you must have achieved at least a grade 6. |
| German | A minimum of three grade $6 s$ and five grade $5 s$ at GCSE including a grade 6 in GCSE German. |


| Graphics | You must have obtained a grade 4 in GCSE English Language or English Literature, plus four further <br> higher grade passes (this includes grade 4 or above in GCSE subjects or Level 2 Pass or above in BTEC <br> subjects) including grade 4 in GCSE Graphics or GCSE Art or GCSE Product Design or GCSE Textiles. |
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| History | A minimum of three grade 6 s and five grade 5 s at GCSE including a grade 6 in GCSE English Language or <br> English Literature. If GCSE History was studied, you must have achieved at least a grade 6. |
| Mathematics | A minimum of three grade 6 s and five grade 5 s at GCSE including a grade 7 in GCSE Maths. |
| Photography | A minimum of five grade 5 s at GCSE including a grade 5 in GCSE Art or GCSE Graphics or GCSE Product <br> Design and preferably including a grade 4 in GCSE English Language and GCSE Maths. However, <br> students with a genuine interest in photography will be considered for the course. |
| Physical <br> Education | A minimum of five grade $5 s$ at GCSE including a grade 5 in GCSE English Language or Literature and <br> GCSE Maths. (You do not need to have studied GCSE PE, however, good practical sports performance <br> (including regular participation in a club / competition) is essential). |
| Physics | A minimum of three grade $6 s$ and five grade $5 s$ at GCSE including a grade 6 in Maths GCSE and grade 7 <br> Physics GCSE or Combined Science. |
| Psychology | A minimum of three grade $6 s$ and five grade $5 s$ at GCSE including a grade 6 in GCSE English Language or <br> English Literature, a grade 5 in GCSE Biology or Chemistry and a grade 5 in GCSE Maths. |
| Sociology | A minimum of three grade $6 s$ and five grade $5 s$ at GCSE including a grade 6 in GCSE English Language or <br> English Literature. |

## BTEC LEVEL 3 COURSE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

| National Extended Certificate Applied Human Biology | You must have achieved GCSE grade 4 in GCSE English Language OR English Literature, Maths and either Biology or Combined Science, plus 1 further higher grade pass (this includes grade 4 or above in GCSE subjects or Level 2 Pass or above in BTEC subjects). |
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| National Diploma Business Studies | You must have obtained a grade 4 in GCSE English Language or English Literature and Maths, plus three further higher grade passes (this includes grade 4 or above in GCSE subjects or Level 2 Pass or above in BTEC subjects). |
| National Diploma IT | You must have obtained a grade 4 in GCSE English Language or English Literature and Maths, plus three further higher grade passes (this includes grade 4 or above in GCSE subjects or Level 2 Pass or above in BTEC subjects). |
| National Diploma Sport | You must have obtained a grade 4 in GCSE English Language or English Literature, plus four further higher grade passes (this includes grade 4 or above in GCSE subjects or Level 2 Pass or above in BTEC subjects). |
| National Diploma Health \& Social Care | You must have obtained a grade 4 in GCSE English Language or English Literature, plus four further higher grade passes (this includes grade 4 or above in GCSE subjects or Level 2 Pass or above in BTEC subjects). |
| National Extended Certificate Applied Psychology | You must have obtained a grade 4 in GCSE English Language or English Literature, plus four further higher grade passes (this includes grade 4 or above in GCSE subjects or Level 2 Pass or above in BTEC subjects). |
| OTHER COURSES ENTRY REQUIREMENTS |  |
| Extended Project Qualification (EPQ) | Predominately grade 5 s at GCSE including a grade 5 in English Language or Literature along with a keen interest in a particular subject area. |
| AS Further Maths | A minimum of five grade 6 s and three grade 5 s at GCSE including a grade 8 in GCSE Maths. |
