Biddulph Sixth Form does not have a uniform. The dress-code is smart and casual clothing, which is comfortable, practical, modest and suitable for a school environment e.g. example, trousers, jeans, t-shirts, hoodies, tracksuits and dresses. - Ripped jeans
- Fishnet tights or stockings
- Very short skirts or shorts
- Hoods and hats should not be worn inside the building for safeguarding reasons.
