## Year 11 Results Day 2026

GCSE and Level 2 results will be available for collection from 9:00am until 11am on Thursday 20 August, 2026.

Should a student not be able to collect the results in person on these days then their alternative options will be:

- Results can be collected on their behalf by a nominated family member or friend. For results to be released to the nominated person, they must present a letter authorising them to collect the results and this must be signed by the student.
- Results can be posted to the home address. Students wishing to use this option will need to leave a SAE with a stamp attached with Miss Deavall prior to the school closing at 13:15pm on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> July, 2026.
- Results can be collected once school reopens on Tuesday 1 September, 2026.
- Please note that we are not permitted to email results home.

Support for students collecting results will be available during the times listed above. Should support be needed outside of the results day collection times, then students must email:

Please do not call the School Office as no one will be available during the holidays to answer calls. Further information about contact and support following results day will be in the results envelopes.

## Education Record

We will be issuing digital education records to year 11 pupils on results day.

Education records are part of a new service from the Department for Education (DfE) to provide pupils with their education information and help them share these details as part of their post-16 journey.

Education records contain unique education information for each pupil, including:

- their name, address and date of birth
- the schools they have attended
- their qualifications (after results are released)





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- any support needs

Education records will be issued on the DfE education record app. Pupils must download the app onto their phones from the Apple or Google App Stores. The rest of the issuing process will take place in school on results day, there will be a desk set up to validate the students account.

The Apple version of the app requires iOS version 15.0 or newer and the Android version requires 8.1 or newer. Please download this before results day. After the issuing process, pupils will have their education information on their phones. To find out more here is short video created by the DfE <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=ZSg32VhCHSw>

### **Exam Support and Guidance**

If you believe there is an error that impacted your grade, talk to your subject teacher at school. They can give you more information about how your grade was decided, grade boundaries and unit marks. We also strongly recommend that when considering your next steps, you take time to read through the 'JCQ Post-Results Services, Summer 2026'.

If you decide that you require a centre review or an appeal, we can request an 'Exam board reviews of results' to review marking, review moderation or a clerical re-check. To action this, you must complete the you must complete 'Clerical rechecks, reviews of marking and appeals' candidate consent form (found within the results day envelop or available under 'Exams' on the school website and return to school via email to [vdeavall@bhs.potteries.ac.uk](mailto:vdeavall@bhs.potteries.ac.uk) Once this paper work is received, we will make arrangements for payment ahead of the request to the exam board. No review of results will be submitted until payment is received. Following a review of marking, if the overall subject grade changes (up or down) the exam board will refund the fee.
